The notices generated from these centers will indicate "St. Nicholas" or "Queensboro" Job Center in the top left-hand corner of the notice instead of "Office of Employment Services," and the Income Support Center number (26 or 51) will appear in the "IM Center" field.

In processing requests pursuant to these notices, Communications Intake Staff can combine non-employment and employment-related issues in one request. An edit has been programmed into FHIS that will not allow SP02 to be entered in the Subcategory field for Job Centers 26 or 51. Please note: Since the scheduling of SP02 calendars has been discontinued, it is no longer necessary to enter SP02 in the Subcategory field on any request.
