

Effective June 23, 2003, local Upstate districts and NYC agencies began receiving electronic Dispositions of Fair Hearing (OAH-2846) via the BICS (Upstate) or PDS (NYC) print queue or on-line notification via DEPCON. This information includes final dispositions after hearing such as Heard and Default that would be of particular interest to agencies that have been granted a waiver of personal appearance by this office and were not present at the hearing.
