Effective August 1, 1998, pursuant to an amendment in the Social Services Law and Chapter 19 of the Laws of 1998, clients enrolled in Managed Care will no longer receive pharmacy services (prescription and over-the-counter drugs and medical supplies) through their Medicaid Managed Care plan but rather through the Medicaid program. Medicaid recipients will need to use their Medicaid Benefit Card and a pharmacy that accepts Medicaid to obtain coverage for pharmacy services. Issue code 955, Managed Care--Removal of Pharmacy Coverage, has been established to track fair hearing requests concerning this issue. The coding is as follows:
