Effective June 24, 1999, a new procedure has been implemented whereby receipt of a returned DSS-4420 (Notice of Acknowledgement of Fair Hearing Request and Confirmation of Aid Status) will be entered on the Fair Hearing Information System (FHIS). Scheduling Unit staff, working on the Change Appellant Information Screen (08 PFHCNG), will scan from a selection of bar codes the reason for the return as well as the date of processing. This will result in a message appearing in the message field on the Appellant Information Screen (PFINQ1). The returned DSS-4420 will then be discarded.

The following is a list of the return reason codes and their definitions:

- D Deceased
- FOE Forwarding Order Expired
- I Insufficient Address
- M Moved, Not Forwardable, Left No Address
- NO No Such Number, No Such Street
- R Refused
- U Unclaimed
