MINIMUM WAGE LETTER (EXP-78T)

<p><input type="checkbox"/> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Please use Print on Demand to obtain copies of forms.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center staff about a mailing by Management Information Systems (MIS) to inform all employed public assistance (PA) participants of the increase in the New York State minimum wage to \$6.75 per hour as of January 1, 2006.</p> <p>The Minimum Wage Letter (EXP-78T) to remind PA participants of their responsibility to inform the Agency of any change in income within 10 days of receipt of the income and has been updated to indicate the new minimum wage rate for 2006.</p> <p>Staff must initiate a new automated Job Notice (FIA-3A) whenever a participant reports new or a change in employment income.</p> <p>A sample of the form is attached.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p> <p>Attachments:</p> <p>EXP-78T Minimum Wage Letter (Rev. 1/4/06) EXP-78T (S) Minimum Wage Letter (Spanish) (Rev. 1/4/06)</p>

Dear Participant:

The New York State Legislature increased the minimum wage rate from \$6 per hour to \$6.75 per hour as of January 1, 2006. As a result, you may receive an increase in pay if your current rate of pay is at or below \$6 per hour.

We wish you continued success in your employment and remind you that you can contact your employment vendor or Job Center to find out about programs available to help you improve your skills.

Finally, we want to remind you that as a condition of continued eligibility for public assistance, you must report any change in income within ten (10) days of receipt of the income. If this increase in the minimum wage results in an increase in pay for you or any member of your household, you must report it to your Job Center within ten (10) days.



Estimado(a) Participante:

La Asamblea Legislativa del Estado de Nueva York ratificó un aumento del sueldo mínimo de \$6 a \$6.75 la hora en vigor a partir del 1ero de enero, 2006. Por consiguiente, puede que dicho aumento le sea de aplicación si su sueldo actual es de \$6 o menos por hora.

Queremos que usted siga triunfando en su empleo y le recordamos que puede comunicarse con su proveedor de empleo o con el Centro de Trabajo (Job Center) para averiguar sobre programas disponibles que le ayudarán a mejorar sus habilidades.

Por último, queremos recordarle que como requisito de elegibilidad para asistencia pública, usted debe informar de cualquier cambio en sus ingresos dentro de diez (10) días de haberle afectado dicho cambio. Si este aumento del sueldo mínimo resulta en un aumento de su salario o el de algún miembro de su hogar, usted debe reportarlo a su Centro de Empleo dentro de diez (10) días.
