<p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p>Eligible Participants</p> <p>Worked previously for Parks</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to provide Job Center staff with information regarding changes in the referral process to the Parks Opportunity Program (POP).</p> <p>Participants in active (AC) status who have been in receipt of PA for at least 12 months may now be referred to the Parks Opportunity Program for employment if the participant is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully employable (employability status [ES] code 20); or • Employable with minimal accommodations (employability status [ES] code 16) (This includes participants coded 16 by Wellness, Comprehensive Assessment, Rehabilitation and Employment [WeCARE]) <p>In addition, all participants meeting the above criteria who previously participated in POP from the year 2001 through 2003 and who <u>were not terminated</u> with good cause from the Parks and Recreation (Parks) Department may be reassigned to the POP.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p>
