LIFELINE POLICY

February 24, 2006	Welfare Management System (WMS)					
☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to remind all Job Center and Non-Public Assistance Food Stamp (NPA FS) Office staff that applicants and participants may choose to "opt-out" of the Lifeline Program, a discounted telephone service available to low-income households. This policy bulletin serves as information for all other staff.					
Automatic enrollment in the Lifeline Program is not guaranteed to all low-income applicants/participants.	Currently, the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) shares the names and addresses of public assistance (PA) and NPA FS participants with Verizon for possible automatic enrollment in the Lifeline Program. Release of the information does not guarantee the automatic enrollment in the Lifeline Program.					
	PA and NPA FS applicants and participants must be afforded the opportunity to "opt-out" of the release of their information by OTDA to their local telephone service provider. Therefore, language that will allow PA and NPA FS applicants and participants to "opt-out" of OTDA's releasing of information to their local telephone service provider has been added to the following forms:					
	 LDSS-2921 (Common Application) LDSS-3174 (Recertification Form) LDSS-4826 (Food Stamp Benefits Application/Recertification). 					
Enter a checkmark in the Lifeline checkbox to "opt- out" of the Lifeline Program.	There is an authorization notice on these forms that explains what information will be released by OTDA and the purpose for the released information. A checkbox to indicate the applicant/participant's desire not to release the information is also included in this authorization notice. (Refer to page 16 of LDSS-2921, page 16 of LDSS-3174 and page five of LDSS-4826.) A Lifeline data element input field (LFLN) has been added to Worker Mode Application Data screen (NAPP05). The LFLN field can be

modified through the Eligibility and Undercare subsystems using the Lifeline Participation Code Data Entry Form (LDSS-4855).


The **LFLN** field will <u>not</u> be displayed on the WMS/NYC Authorization Turnaround Document (**LDSS-3517**). JOS/Workers may confirm the value (blank or **N**) in the **LFLN** field by reviewing the following WMS Inquiry screens:


- NQCS01 (Case Composition Suffix/Individual Summary)
- NQCS02 (Case Composition Suffix Summary)
- NQCS3A (Current Case Composition Historical Suffix Information)
- NQCS3B (Case Composition Individual Summary as of mm/dd/yy).

Job Centers

In the Paperless Office System (POS), the Lifeline checkbox will be blank when the **Additional Suffix Level Data** window is opened in the Application and Recertification Interview activities. To provide applicants/participants previously enrolled in Lifeline with an opportunity to opt out of the program, JOS/Workers must:

- Click on the checkbox,
- Read the script and question to the applicant/participant and
- Record the response to the question.





If the applicant/participant has checked the checkbox on the application or recertification form this indicates that the applicant/participant does not want his/her information released. When a **No** response to the Lifeline question is entered and the **OK** button is clicked. POS will automatically enter No in the LFLN field of the LDSS-3517 and an N in WMS to prevent the release of information.

NPA FS Offices

If the applicant/participant has checked the checkbox on the application or recertification form this indicates that the applicant/participant does not want his/her information released. Workers must enter an N in WMS to prevent the release of information by using the LDSS-4855.

All locations

If the checkbox is blank, this indicates that the applicant/recipient agrees to have his/her information released to the telephone service provider for possible automatic enrollment in the Lifeline Program. The JOS/Worker does not need to take action since a blank LFLN field will allow the release of recipient information to the telephone service provider. No further action is required.
