2009 CHILDCARE MARKET RATES

Date: March 29, 2010	Subtopic(s): Childcare
<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center staff that the child care market rates have changed. It is informational for all other staff.</p> <p>The State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) establish new maximum child care market rates every two years. The child care market rate determines the maximum amount that the agency can pay to providers who care for children eligible for a child care subsidy. The 2009 market rates became effective on October 1, 2009. These rates are listed on the attached Maximum Child Care Rates form (W-667F).</p> <p>New York City Children's' Services (ACS) has updated the rate of all active providers in the Automated Childcare Information System (ACCIS). JOS Workers and ACS Childcare Specialists should not make any rate changes for active providers in ACCIS. Future rate change requests will be processed by ACS. However, JOS/Child Care Specialists should apply the new market rates (in ACCIS) for new legally exempt childcare providers.</p> <p>Staff must use the W-667F to determine the maximum rate applicable to the type of provider used. The actual amount requested by the provider can be paid up to the maximum child care rate shown. An enhanced market rate is available for legally exempt childcare providers who annually complete ten or more hours of training approved and verified by the enrollment agency (Women's Housing and Economic Development Corporation [WHEDCO]).</p>
