CHILDCARE DURING SPRING BREAK 2010

Date: April 2, 2010	Subtopic(s): Childcare
<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff that participants, with school age children, who were unable to make alternate childcare arrangements for the period when public schools were closed for spring break (March 29-April 6, 2010) should be excused from their work assignments.</p> <p>While some parents/guardians made arrangements for the period when school was closed, not all may have been able to do so. The Human Resources Administration (HRA) must allow excused absences for those participants who were unable to report to their assignment during the spring break because he/she could not make alternate childcare arrangements for children age 5 through 12 or under the age of 19 with special needs.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p> <p>Related Item:</p> <p>PD #09-38-OPE</p>
