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## POLICY BULLETIN #11-108-OPE (This Policy Bulletin obsoletes PB #10-29-OPE)

### 2011-2013 CHILDCARE MARKET RATES

<b>Date:</b> November 22, 2011	<b>Subtopic(s):</b> Childcare, ACCIS
<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center staff that the childcare market rates have changed. It is informational for all other staff.</p> <p>The State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) establishes new maximum childcare market rates every two years. The childcare market rate determines the maximum amount that the agency can pay to providers who care for children eligible for a childcare subsidy. The 2011 market rates became effective on October 1, 2011. These current rates are listed on the attached Maximum Childcare Rates form (<b>W-667F</b>).</p> <p>Staff must use the <b>W-667F</b> to determine the maximum rate applicable to the type of provider used. JOS Workers must apply the new market rates (in ACCIS) for <b>new</b> legally-exempt childcare providers. The actual amount requested by the provider can be paid up to the maximum childcare rate shown.</p> <p>JOS Workers cannot make any rate changes for providers already active in the Automated Childcare Information System (ACCIS). Only New York City Children’s Services (ACS) can update the rates of all active providers in the ACCIS. All rate change requests must be made to ACS and ACS will update the rate if the increase is justified. A provider cannot increase his/her rates just because of the increase of the childcare market rate.</p> <p>If a parent(s) comes into the Job Center inquiring about the new market rates, inform him/her that more information can be found on the ACS website at <a href="http://www.nyc.gov/acs">www.nyc.gov/acs</a> and then by clicking the “Childcare and Head Start” link on the left hand side of the page.</p>
