## FOOD STAMP (FS) TRANSITIONAL BENEFIT ALTERNATIVE (TBA), SEPARATE DETERMINATION (SEP DET) AND "ONE-SHOT" OPENINGS

| This procedure can<br>now be accessed on the<br>FIAweb. | <b>Purpose</b><br>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to clarify that recent Welfare<br>Management System (WMS) edits for Food Stamp (FS) Transitional<br>Benefit Alternative (TBA), Separate Determination (SEP DET) and<br>"One Shot" openings are applicable <u>only when the "One Shot" case</u><br>is opened using the Eligibility subsystem by registering the case in<br>Application (AP) status. The instructions in this policy bulletin are for<br>JOS/Workers and other Job Center staff, and are informational for all<br>other staff. |
|   | Policy  |
|   | Effective in March 2011, WMS issued edits to ensure that FS TBA/SEP DET benefits will not be affected when a case is reopened to issue a "Onetime Emergency" benefit.   |
|   | Previously, when Cash Assistance (CA) cases were reopened for a<br>"Onetime Emergency" CA Single Issue (SI) benefit, the associated<br>FS TBA/SEP DET benefits were interrupted and benefit amounts<br>were being incorrectly reduced to zero. Since these "One Shot"<br>openings do not require a budget, the FS TBA/SEP DET amount<br>was adjusted to zero and nothing was issued for the remainder of the<br>FS TBA/SEP DET period.  |

This occurred in the following two situations:

|                        | <ul> <li>A FS TBA/SEP DET was issued on a closed CA/FS case (using FS reason codes B11 [Transitional FS – Increase in FS], B12 [Transitional FS – Same FS Amount], or B26 [FS Extend on PA case – Non TBA]) and a "One Shot" opening was done before the FS certification period expired.</li> </ul>   |

|                        | <ul> <li>A CA/FS case was closed, extending FS for one month on the closed CA case (using FS reason codes B13 [Transitional FS – Separate Determination at higher amount], B14 [Transitional FS – Separate Determination Same Amount], or B15 [FS – Separate Determination – Non TBA]). Before the FS TBA/SEP DET case was opened, the original CA/FS case was opened for a "One Shot."</li> </ul> |
|                        | The recent WMS edits ensure that FS TBA/SEP DET benefits are<br>not affected when a case is reopened to issue a "Onetime<br>Emergency" benefit. FS TBA/SEP DET benefits will remain the<br>same and will not be reduced to zero. A budget is not required for<br>the CA/FS case, and if a budget is entered, it will be ignored.   |
|                        | In order for the edits to work, the JOS/Worker must register the case<br>for CA in AP status for a One Shot Emergency (MA and FS must be<br>in NA status). These edits will <u>not</u> work if the case is activated using<br>Undercare.   |
|                        | The edits will work when one of the following CA opening codes is used via the Eligibility Subsystem and entered on the AP/NA/NA Turn-Around Document (TAD) linked back to the closed case:  |

Refer to <u>Worker's Guide</u> to <u>Codes</u> for detailed information on opening codes. **Note:** All the codes listed are not "Onetime Emergency" opening codes; they are used to **SI** a case and issue a "One Shot" benefit. For example, Code **Y46** must be used to **SI** a case that was closed due to an employment infraction.
