## REMAPPING OF THE WECARE MEDICAL SITES FOR BROOKLYN JOB CENTERS

This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to advise staff that a new Wellness, Comprehensive Assessment, Rehabilitation and Employment (WeCARE) vendor is responsible for conducting medical assessments in Brooklyn.
	Effective Tuesday, February 7, 2012, with the exception of the Dekalb Job Center ( <b>#64</b> ), WeCARE referrals from Brooklyn Job Centers and multi-zip code Job Centers (e.g., Michael J. Handy Veterans' Job Center [ <b>#62</b> ]) that service households from zip codes beginning with 112 were mapped to the WeCARE medical assessment site located at 1420 Bushwick Avenue, Brooklyn, NY.
	The Bushwick Avenue site is operated by NARCO Freedom as a subcontractor to HRA's Customized Assistance Services (CAS) WeCARE vendor, ResCare Workforce Services.
	ResCare plans to call in the approximately 2,500 clients in the WeCARE Awaiting Medical Referral pools.
Job Center <b>#64</b> WeCARE referrals are mapped to FEGS' Manhattan site.	Additionally, WeCARE referrals from Dekalb Job Center <b>#64</b> are now mapped to the Federated Employment and Guidance Services' (FEGS) Manhattan site located at 344 West 51st Street, New York, NY 10019.
Job Center <b>#79</b> WeCARE referrals are mapped to ResCare's Queens site.	Rockaway Job Center ( <b>#79</b> ) WeCARE referrals which were formally mapped to the Bushwick Multi-Service Family Center are now mapped to ResCare's WeCARE site, located at 37-19 33rd Street, Long Island City, Queens, NY.
