EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION DOCUMENT (EAD) (I-766)

<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p>Note: Staff may still see older cards with the lower case alpha numeric.</p> <div data-bbox="147 1646 446 1772" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content;"> <p>New alpha numeric code with Capital letters</p> </div>	<p>The purpose of this Policy Bulletin is to inform Cash Assistance (CA) and Non-Cash Assistance (NCA) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) staff about updated code usages on the Employment Authorization Document (EAD) (I-766).</p> <p>The I-766, which is issued by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) agency, provides evidence that an immigrant is authorized to be employed in the United States by a United States employer.</p> <p>Formerly, an alpha numeric code beginning with a lower case letter (e.g., a1, b2, c3, etc.) was used on the I-766 to indicate an individual's immigration status.</p> <p>USCIS now designates an individual's immigration status on the I-766 through the use of three position alpha numeric codes beginning with capital letters A, B, or C (e.g., A05, B03, C09, etc.).</p> <div data-bbox="574 1354 1317 1772" style="text-align: center;">  </div>
