DEPENDENT CHILD INDICATOR

Date: February 27, 2014	Subtopic(s): WMS
☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to remind Job Center staff that when generating a Client Notices System (CNS) Notice to impose an employment related sanction, that he/she must verify the case composition.
	Employment related sanctions have different durations. The determining factors of the length of the sanction are the number of prior infractions and whether or not there is a dependent child in the household.
Enter Y c	Note : A dependent child is defined as either a person under 18 years of age, or under 19 years of age and a full-time student.
	When creating a CNS Notice for an employment related sanction the JOS/Worker must enter either Yes (Y) or No (N) on the WMS/Client Notice Subsystem (WGN151) screen to indicate whether or not a dependent child is in the household to ensure that the proper sanction period is applied.

The dependent child indicator will only appear when one of the following employment related sanctions is being imposed on either a Safety Net Cash Assistance (SNCA) case or a Safety Net Non Cash Assistance (SNNC) case:

- **N41** (Voluntary Quit 1st Occurrence)
- N42 (Voluntary Quit 2nd Occurrence)
- **N43** (Voluntary Quit 3rd Occurrence [and Subsequent])
- **WE1** (Failure to Comply with Employment Requirements [1st Occurrence])
- WE2 (Output Code for 2nd Instance of Noncompliance with Employment Requirements)
- **WE3** (Output Code for 3rd and Subsequent Instances of Noncompliance with Employment Requirements)
- **WX1** (Failure to Comply with Employment Requirements 1st Occurrence [HH=1])
- WX2 (Failure to Comply with Employment Requirements 2nd Occurrence [HH=1]) Public assistance
- **WX3** (Failure to Comply with Employment Requirements 3rd and Subsequent Occurrences [HH=1])
