The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all staff that the Mandated Job Center Signage (M-98c) and the Mandated Non Cash Assistance Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (NCA SNAP) Center Signage (M-98d) lists have been updated.  The M-98c has been updated as follows:  A new poster titled "Pregnancy and Employment Rights" (POST-124) has been added. The revision date on the "Infoline Poster" (POST-98) has been updated. The revision date on the "Infoline Poster" (FIA-35 and FIA-35 [S]) has been changed to POST-101 and POST-101 (S) and is no longer an FIA form. The dimensions have also changed.  "Will You Receive Food Stamp Benefits After Cash Assistance Ends?" (PUB-4792 and PUB 4792-SP) has become "Will You Receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) After Cash Assistance Ends?"
