The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all staff that the Mandated Job Center Signage (M-98c) and the Mandated Non Cash Assistance Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (NCA SNAP) Center Signage (M-98d) lists have been updated. The M-98c and M-98d have been revised as follows: The "Notice-Sexual Harassment" sign (W-766) has become the "Notice-Sexual Harassment Policy" sign (POST-125). The title, identification number, and poster date have all been updated. The "The EEO is the law" sign (W-766S) has been revised and renumbered to POST-125a. The identification number and the poster date have been updated. The "People with Disabilities Have Rights" sign (W-766B) has become the "Notice-Reasonable Accommodation" sign (POST-125b). The title, identification number, and poster date have all been updated. The "Protect Your EBT Benefits" sign (W-917) has been revised and renumbered to POST-108. The identification number of the "Stop Medicaid Fraud" sign (DOH-3362) has been corrected. The "State of New York Division of Human Rights" sign (FIA-65) has been renumbered and is now POST-100. The "Casale/Brown Class Action Lawsuit Settlement Notice" sign (POST-107) and (POST-107(S)) are now obsolete and should be removed.

Reminder: Use Print on Demand to obtain copies of signs smaller than 11 x 17 and signs not required to be displayed in color. Only signs 11 x 17 or larger, or signs required to be displayed in color should be ordered for reprint using the Central Intake Work Flow System (CIWS) by selecting the POSTER category.

Job Center and NCA SNAP Center Directors must ensure that all previous versions of the **M-98c** and **M-98d** are removed and recycled and that all mandated signage in their center is updated according to the most recent versions of the **M-98c** and **M-98d**.
