WAIVER OF THE ABLE-BODIED ADULTS WITHOUT DEPENDENTS (ABAWD) TIME LIMITS

(This Policy Bulletin Replaces PB #23-11-ELI)

Date: October 3, 2023	Subtopic(s): ABAWD
October 3, 2023	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Benefits Access Center (BAC), HIV/AIDS Services Administration (HASA) and Non-Cash Assistance (NCA) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Center staff that the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) has obtained an extension of a statewide waiver of the Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWD) time limits through February 28, 2025.
	Prior to this new extension, New York State was approved for a statewide waiver through February 29, 2024.
	As a result of the statewide waiver, the Agency is not required to send the Important Information About SNAP Work Rules (General, Mandatory E&T, and ABAWD) (FIA-1250) but is still required to send the Important Information About SNAP Work Rules (General and Mandatory E&T) (FIA-1251) for households with individuals determined to be subject to the general SNAP work rules and/or the mandatory SNAP Employment and Training (E&T) requirements.
	In addition, the Agency is not required to offer and provide an ABAWD qualifying work activity to those ABAWDs who were not independently meeting the ABAWD work requirements.
	Staff must continue to determine an individual's SNAP employability status code and ABAWD Indicator code. All individuals who are determined to be ABAWDs must be assigned ABAWD Indicator Code A (ABAWD), while those who are not ABAWDs must be assigned ABAWD Indicator Code N (non-ABAWD). No individuals are to be assigned ABAWD Indicator Code W (Waived) at this time.
	Staff must also continue to read the General SNAP Work Requirements Script and the ABAWD Script as described in PB #20-05-OPE.
