### **SPECIAL MAILING OF JIGGETTS REDUCTION NOTICES**

<b>Date:</b> August 25, 2006	Subtopic(s): Jiggetts			
☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	This policy bulletin is to inform all Job Center staff of a special mailing conducted by the New York State (NYS) Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) to inform certain households of a reduction in the amount of <u>Jiggetts</u> shelter supplement they will receive each month. This reduction is due to an edit in the Welfare Management System (WMS) that limits the amount of rent payable to the actual amount approved by the State. The reduction will begin with the September A cycle. This policy bulletin serves as information for all other staff.			
The State notice regarding this correction does not carry Fair Hearing rights.	As the change to the <u>Jiggetts</u> shelter supplement is not administered by the Human Resources Administration (HRA), if the participant has questions regarding the reduction or notice (see <b>Attachment A</b> ), staff should direct the participant to the legal services provider or organization which last assisted him/her in applying for <u>Jiggetts</u> or to one of the certified community-based organizations listed on the notice for assistance. Staff is not authorized to make changes to the participant's shelter supplement unless a new approval letter is issued by OTDA.

### **PUBLIC ASSISTANCE GRANT:**

You are currently receiving a rent supplement under the <u>Jiggetts</u> intervention process. The <u>Jiggetts</u> rent supplement is a special payment over your public assistance shelter allowance as a result of pending litigation in Jiggetts v. Dowling (Sup. Ct, N.Y. County).

There was an error in the issuance of your <u>Jiggetts</u> rent supplement. We are therefore correcting your <u>Jiggetts</u> rent supplement to the amount you should receive based on the information that we have on file concerning your rent, household composition and income.

You were previously contacted about your <u>Jiggetts</u> rent supplement, and this correction is a result of the information received regarding your case or because of failure to respond to the previous notice.

#### PUBLIC ASSISTANCE GRANT

These special supplements are not handled by HRA. If you disagree with the correction to your rent supplement described in this letter you should immediately contact the last organization which helped you apply for <u>Jiggetts</u> or one of the four organizations listed at the end of this letter to schedule an appointment. These organizations can help you submit an application to OTDA to change your <u>Jiggetts</u> rent supplement. Your HRA Job Center is not authorized to make changes to your rent supplement unless a new approval letter is issued by OTDA after an application by a legal services program or a certified community based organization. Bring this letter with you to a legal services program or certified community based organization, along with information about your prior <u>Jiggetts</u> approvals, your leases since you were last approved, the income of everyone who lives in your home, your public assistance budget and any papers you have received from your landlord or your HRA Job Center.
