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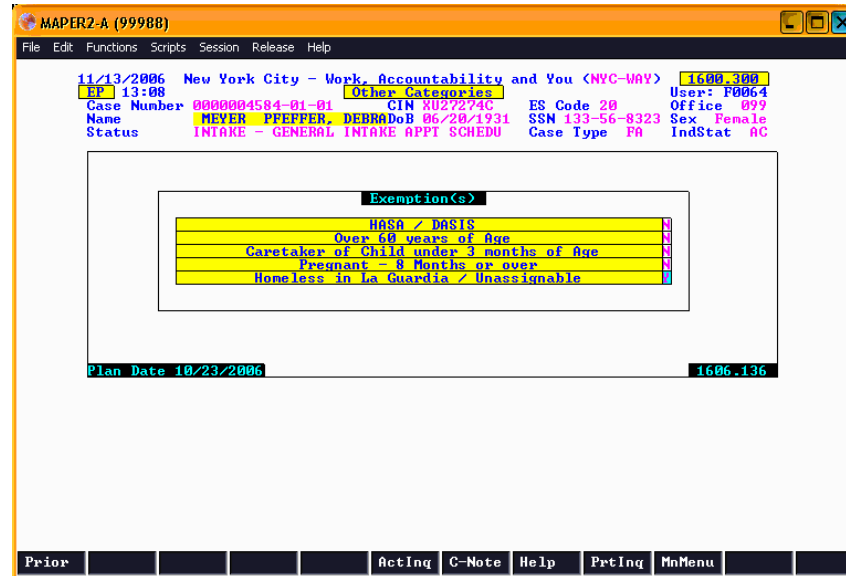

### NYCWAY UPDATES – EP AND ACTION CODE CHANGES

The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff of the following updates made to NYCWAY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Other Personal Issues – Participant Exemption Changes</li> <li>• New Wellness, Comprehensive Assessment, Rehabilitation and Employment (WeCARE) Vendor Action Codes</li> <li>• New Training Assessment Group (TAG) Child Care Codes <b>133E</b> (TAG CC Return Appointment – Documentation) and <b>133F</b> (TAG CC Return Appointment – Provider)</li> </ul> <p>Previously all exemptions for participants were posted outside the Employability Plan (EP). Workers can now post the exemptions from within the EP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When a <b>Y</b> is entered for <b>Other Personal Issues?</b> on the <b>Primary Questionnaire</b> screen for participants, the <b>Other Categories</b> screen listing the exemption categories appears.</li> </ul>

New screen – Other Categories



- Once a Y is entered and transmitted from any one of the six categories listed above, the corresponding action code listed below will be made available to post:

Category	Code	Description
HIV Aids Services Administration (HASA)/Division of Aids Services and Income Support (DASIS)	<b>199V</b>	Verified Sanctioned (SN)/ Unassigned
Over 60 Years of Age	<b>185V</b>	Over 60 Years of Age
Caretaker of Child Under 3 Months of Age	<b>195</b> or <b>196</b>	Caretaker of Child Under 13 Weeks on PA Case Caretaker of NPA Child Under 13 Weeks
Pregnant – 8 Months or Over	<b>184P</b>	8–9 Months Pregnant
Homeless in LaGuardia/Unassignable	<b>191L</b>	Homeless/LaGuardia/ Unassignable

Action Code **196** exempts the PA individual if the child under 13 weeks is on the case for FS only.

The following new action codes serve as payment milestone codes for WeCARE vendors to post on participants who previously received WeCARE services but are no longer enrolled in WeCARE.

- 16PB** WeCARE BPS I Completed
- 16PC** WeCARE CSP Substantially Completed
- 16PE** WeCARE No Functional Limitation
- 16PI** WeCARE IPE Complete
- 16PJ** WeCARE Job Placement
- 16PL** WeCARE Employable Requiring Voc Rehab Services
- 16PM** WeCARE Employable with Minimal Accommodation
- 16PP** WeCARE BPS II Completed
- 16PS** WeCARE Unable to Work
- 16PT** WeCARE Temporarily Unable to Work
- 16PV** WeCARE Wellness Plan Completed

New TAG Child  
Care Codes **133E**  
and **133F**

Effective December 15, 2006, TAG Child Care Return Appointment Action Codes **133E** and **133F** will be offered to post through the EP by TAG workers only, instead of the **133D** (Child Care Return Appt – Documentation Needed) and the **133S** (Child Care Return Appointment – Provider Needed).

*Effective Immediately*
