The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff of the following updates made to NYCWAY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Action Codes Deactivated • New Wellness, Comprehensive Assessment, Rehabilitation and Employment (WeCARE) Vendor Action Codes 172F (Assigned to WeCARE Training Full Time) and 172T (Assigned to WeCARE Training Part Time) • Batch Posting of Action Code 109J (Call-In Letter – Temporary Unemployable Notice) <p>Action Code 191I (Referred for Special Assessment – Alien) has been deactivated because the code is no longer needed as per the State. The following action codes, which are outcomes for the 191I, have also been deactivated:</p> <p>131G (Special Assessment Appointment Kept – Waiver Granted) 131J (Special Assessment Appointment Kept – No Waiver) 131K (FTR Special Assessment Appointment)</p> <p>Action Codes 172F and 172T are entered by WeCARE vendors to refer a participant from Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) to full-time or part-time Voucher Individualized Training Assignment (ITA) training.</p>

Batch Posting of
Action Code **109J**

For all participants with the following open action codes, NYCWAY will batch post Action Code **109J**.

- **303T** SDX: Payment Terminated
- **305B** SDX: SSI Denied – Excess Income
- **305C** SDX: SSI Denied – Excess Resources
- **306** SDX: SSI Denied – Client Engaged in Substantial Gainful Activity-Working
- **306B** SDX: SSI Denied – Client Engaged in Substantial Gainful Activity-Working

Some participants will be called in to the Job Center because they were denied Social Security Supplemental Income (SSI) for excess income or resources. Others will be called in because they were working when the SSI claim was denied. These participants may have applied for SSI without being referred to WeCARE. In addition to evaluating the participant's income and/or resources for continued eligibility, the participant's employability status must also be reevaluated.

- If the participant is currently enrolled in WeCARE, take no further action.
- If the participant is not in WeCARE and claims a medical barrier to employment, refer the participant to WeCARE as per current procedure.
- If the participant is employable, complete the Employability Plan (EP) and assign him/her to a work activity if there are no other barriers to employment as per current procedure.
