REPLACEMENT OF THE ALIEN ELIGIBILITY DESK AID (W-205V)

<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p>The LDSS-4579 is available on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to remind staff that the Alien Eligibility Desk Aid (W-205V) was made obsolete in PD #06-24-ELI and was replaced by the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) Alien Eligibility Desk Aid (LDSS-4579).</p> <p>Workers are further reminded to use the LDSS-4579 as a reference when servicing noncitizens applying for assistance. The LDSS-4579 assists with determining what Cash Assistance (CA), Food Stamp (FS) and Medical Assistance (MA) benefits noncitizens are entitled to receive and the category under which CA benefits may be provided, if the noncitizen is otherwise eligible.</p> <p>Center Directors must ensure that all copies of the obsolete W-205V are removed from circulation and recycled.</p> <p>As a result of obsoleting form W-205V, the following policy bulletins are also obsolete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• PB #02-131-ELI• PB #02-245-ELI• PB #03-91-ELI• PB #03-125-ELI• PB #04-98-ELI• PB #05-38-OPE <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p>
