DUAL ENROLLMENTS IN CHILD CARE AND OUT OF SCHOOL TIME (OST) HOURS

	Once the parent/caretaker has demonstrated a need for both types of care, the Worker must annotate the need for and approval of the additional child care by entering a case comment on the Automated Child Care Information System (ACCIS) Child Maintenance screen. If the Administration for Children Services (ACS) receives a match that shows the child is enrolled in two or more types of child care and there is no documentation/case note(s) to support the need for the additional care, the parent/caretaker will be called in to discuss the child care situation and determine if the need for both types of care exist.

If the additional care is not needed, the parent/caretaker must choose the form of care he/she prefers.
