2009 FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL GUIDELINES (EXP-76D)

Date: March 19, 2009	Subtopic(s): Forms, Income, Eligibility
☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all Job Center staff that the 2009 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines (EXP-76D) form has been revised to reflect the 2009 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines that go into effect April 1, 2009.
	The Federal Poverty Level Guidelines on form EXP-76D are applied when a request for Emergency Assistance to Families (EAF) or Emergency Safety Net Assistance (ESNA) is made.
See <u>PD #08-43-ELI</u>	In order for the household to be financially eligible for EAF, the household's available income on the date of application must be at or below 200 percent of the current Federal Poverty Level for that household size, and the applicant must be without the resources to meet the emergency need.
	Note: Workers are reminded that they must explore eligibility for ESNA in instances which a household applying for EAF is deemed ineligible.
	To be financially eligible for ESNA, the household's gross income at the time of application must not exceed 125 percent of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines for the household size.
	Job Center Directors must ensure that the newly revised form EXP-76D is used for determining eligibility of EAF and ESNA as of April 1, 2009 and after. Job Center Directors must retain one copy of the April 18, 2008 version of form EXP-76D to determine eligibility for EAF/ESNA prior to April 1, 2009 and ensure that all previous versions of this form are removed from circulation and recycled.
