2008-2009 HEAP COOLING COMPONENT

July 7, 2009 This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center and Non Cash Assistance Food Stamp (NCA FS) Center staff that the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) opened its Cooling Component on Monday, June 22, 2009. The program will run until Sunday, August 30, 2009 or until funds are no longer available. HEAP will provide eligible households with one air conditioning unit per household. The Cooling Component does not include an additional HEAP cash benefit. Eligibility requirements for the Cooling Component are as follows: Households must have received a 2008-2009 regular HEAP benefit or have income which does not exceed the 2008-2009 regular HEAP benefit guidelines. At least one member of the household must have an acute medical condition that is exacerbated by extreme heat and has been documented in writing by a physician. Households must reside in a HEAP eligible living situation. Households that received a \$1 HEAP payment are not eligible for the Cooling Component.

Applicants aged 60 and over must apply for the HEAP Cooling Component through the New York City Department for the Aging (DFTA), by calling 311. DFTA will secure all required documentation, including medical documentation. If necessary, DFTA will coordinate with the Human Resources Administration (HRA) to verify the applicant's eligibility for HEAP.

All other applicants must apply for the HEAP Cooling Component in person at one of the offices listed in **Attachment A**.
