SUBJECT: Relocation of the HRA BAC Concourse and Grand Concourse HASA

Center #41

This Center Director (CD) Memorandum is being issued to announce the following relocations:

- Effective February 20, 2024, the HRA Benefits Access Center (BAC) Concourse, currently located at 1365 Jerome Avenue 2nd floor, Bronx, NY 10452, will be relocating to 845 Barretto Street 2nd floor, Bronx, NY 10474.
- Effective March 18, 2024, the Grand Concourse HASA Center #41, currently located at 1790 Grand Concourse, Bronx, NY 10457, will be relocating to 1365 Jerome Avenue 2nd floor, Bronx, NY 10452 under the new name Jerome Center #41.

Applicants/Participants will have quick and easy self-service access to many HRA services at the HRA BAC Concourse, as follows:

- <u>Self-Service Check-in Stations (kiosks)</u> at the Center will be used by applicants/participants, so they can self-route to the correct service area by issuing themselves a ticket.
- <u>Self-Service Scanners</u> will allow applicants/participants the option to submit documents without waiting for a Center staff member.
- <u>Personal Computer Banks (PC Banks)</u> will allow participants to submit a Cash Assistance (CA) Application/Recertification form using the ACCESS HRA website.
- <u>Customer Service and Information Center (CSIC)</u> will assist applicants/participants by accessing details about a case and view any pending activities.

Note: Staff must continue to use their access codes for telephonic interpretation services, and their usernames and passwords for the American Sign Language (ASL) video equipment.

The hours of operation at the HRA BAC Concourse are Monday – Friday, 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM, and at the Jerome Center **#41**, the hours of operation are Monday – Friday, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Notices to Applicants/Participants

Information Technology Services (ITS) will send CA participants the Important Information About Changes in Your HRA Benefits Access Center Concourse (**FIA-1070t**) notice. The notice informs current participants that the Center has moved to a new location, but cases will not be affected by this change.

ITS will send HASA participants the Important Information About Changes in Your Grand Concourse Center #41 (SPSVC-14) notice. The notice informs current participants that the Center has moved to a new location under the new name Jerome Center #41, but cases will not be affected by this change.

Samples of the notices are attached.

Center Visitor Policy

Applicants/Participants who report to the Center may bring members of the applying household or members of the case, one additional person, and any person matching the criteria below.

The visitor is accompanying the applicant/participant:

- to act as a case manager, which includes persons representing the homeless who will assist them during the interview;
- to assist with caring for young children during the interview;
- to act as an advocate:
- to serve as a translator/interpreter because the applicant/participant prefers their services to those the Agency provides;
- to assist with physical and/or medical limitations;
- to support the applicant/participant for any situation other than the above.

Note: For HASA visitors, a signed HIPAA-compliant consent form is required for any visitors included in case discussions, as requested by the applicant/participant.

For any additional individual, who does not fit the criteria listed above, Center staff must determine if the visitor's presence is necessary for the applicant/participant.

Note: This will be on a case-by-case basis and is reserved for rare instances, for example, when an applicant/participant needs emotional support or cannot read/write and wants assistance from an individual other than a staff member.
