Background

The BFI-159 Landlord Clearance Letter requires Landlords to verify the names on the lease, the date the lease was signed, the amount of the rent, the number of person(s) in the household, the Landlord and Superintendent of the building and employment references.

Process

The new IREA-154 Landlord Clearance Letter (Attachment 1) replaces the BFI-159 and will be utilized by the Bureau of Fraud Investigation (BFI) and Supplemental Needs Trust (SNT).
