<input type="checkbox"/> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	NYCWAY is updated on a regular basis to make the system more helpful to users, and to update current policy. This policy bulletin is to inform staff of the following updates and enhancements being made to NYCWAY:
Deactivation of Action Code 186F	The Action Code 186F (Federal College Work-Study 20+ Hours per week) has been deactivated because the Action Code 135 series is being used to identify federal college work-study programs.
Parks Restriction	The following participants are restricted from Parks Call-ins (Action Code 105W) and Parks Referrals (Action Code 155G): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants with Shelter Code 41 (Jiggetts-Approved Excess Shelter) • Single Safety Net participants • Participants enrolled in either the EIHP (Additional Needs Type 44) or the LTSP (Additional Needs Type 43)
Autoposting of Action Code 711	When an applicant/participant requests a Fair Hearing to contest employability, NYCWAY will autopost Action Code 711 which will prevent any other employment activities from being posted until the Fair Hearing issue is resolved. <i>Effective Immediately</i>
