CLARIFICATION REGARDING FOOD STAMP ISSUANCE CODE 06

Date: February 13, 2004	Subtopic(s): Food Stamps
☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	The purpose of this bulletin is to clarify for Job Center staff the use of Food Stamp (FS) issuance code 06 (Prorated/Partial PA).
	FS issuance code 06 is used to provide prorated/partial FS benefits to public assistance (PA) applicants who:
	 apply for assistance after the first of the month; are not eligible for expedited FS service (EFS); and whose eligibility for PA and FS has been determined and documented.
	For example, an individual applies for PA and FS on 1/20. He does not meet the criteria for EFS. He is interviewed on the same day and instructed to submit missing documentation by 1/31. The applicant complies with all eligibility requirements and submits the missing documentation by 1/31. The Worker takes action to accept the case on 2/2.
	For FS purposes, the Worker will issue a prorated FS benefit for the month of January to cover the period from 1/20 to 1/31 using FS issuance code 06 . The Worker will also issue the following month's (February) benefit using issuance code 14 (Single Issuance – Full Month).
Do not use Code 06 when the household is eligible for expedited FS service.	Under <u>no</u> circumstances should Workers use issuance code 06 in lieu of issuance codes 52 (Expedited Service) or 54 (Expedited Service – Not Verified for PA/FS Cases) to issue FS benefits to an applicant who is otherwise eligible under the EFS criteria.
