2006 FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL GUIDELINES (EXP-76D)

<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p>See PD #05-02-ELI</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff at the Job/Model Centers that the 2005 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines form (EXP-76D) has been revised to reflect the 2006 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines, which take effect April 1, 2006.</p> <p>The Federal Poverty Level Guidelines on the EXP-76D are applied when a request for Emergency Assistance to Families (EAF) or Emergency Safety Net Assistance (ESNA) is made.</p> <p>In order for the household (H/H) to be financially eligible for EAF, the H/H's available income on the date of application must be at or below 200 percent of the current Federal poverty level for that H/H size and the applicant must be without the resources to meet the emergency need.</p> <p>Note: Workers are reminded they must explore eligibility for ESNA in instances where a H/H applying for EAF is deemed ineligible.</p> <p>To be financially eligible for ESNA, the H/H's gross income at the time of application must not exceed 125 percent of the Federal poverty level guideline for that H/H size.</p> <p>A sample of the form is attached.</p> <p>Center Directors must ensure that all previous versions of this form are recycled.</p> <p><i>Effective April 1, 2006</i></p>
