The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff of the following updates made to NYCWAY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training Assessment Group (TAG) Referrals for Participants with Employability Status (ES) Code 24 (Pregnant –Within 30 Days of Medically Verified Date of Delivery) • New Action Codes 1050 (Eligibility Appointment – Non-Payee) and 118E (CILOPA Employment Documentation Return Appointment) • Action Code 305I (SDX:SSI Denied – Non-Citizen/Non-Eligible Alien) Worklist Change <p>Workers can now refer participants with ES Code 24 to TAG via the Employability Plan (EP).</p> <p>Workers can manually post Action Code 1050 to initiate an eligibility call-in for a nonpayee member of a case.</p> <p>Workers can enter Action Code 118E via the EP to give a participant who is applying for Child Care in Lieu of Public Assistance (CILOPA) a return appointment to bring in the necessary employment documentation if s/he forgets it at the initial appointment. Refer to PD #05-25-ELI for details on CILOPA.</p> <p>Participants with Action Code 305I have been moved from the SSI Worklist to the EXMPT Worklist.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p>
