F11 IS NOW THE FOOD STAMP CHANGE CENTER FOR MANHATTAN

This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	 The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center and Non-Cash Assistance Food Stamp (NCA FS) Center staff that the Union Square Food Stamp Center (F11) ceased accepting new applications for Food Stamps effective March 1, 2008. F11 will operate as the Change Center for other Food Stamp Centers in the Manhattan Region. Change Centers handle the processing of case actions that do not require in person interviews. The NCA FS Centers in Manhattan that will continue to accept new applications are: F02 East End, 2322 Third Avenue, 3rd Floor
	 F13 Washington Heights, 4055 10th Avenue, Lower Level F14 St. Nicholas, 132 West 125th Street, 3rd Floor F19 Waverly, 12 West 14th Street, 4th Floor
	The Non-Cash Assistance Food Stamp Centers and Associated Medicaid Offices form (<u>M42u</u>) and the Food Stamp Income Guidelines form (<u>W-138Q</u>) will be revised to reflect the changes and will be distributed under separate cover.
