☐ This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.	he purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all Job Center staff that the 2008 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines form (EXP-76D) has seen revised to reflect the 2008 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines, hich took effect April 1, 2008.				
	The Federal Poverty Level Guidelines on the EXP-76D are applied when a request for Emergency Assistance to Families (EAF) or Emergency Safety Net Assistance (ESNA) is made.				
See <u>PD #05-02-ELI</u>	In order for the household to be financially eligible for EAF, the household's available income on the date of application must be at or below 200 percent of the current Federal Poverty Level for that household size, and the applicant must be without the resources to meet the emergency need.				
	Note: Workers are reminded that they must explore eligibility for ESNA in instances where a household applying for EAF is deemed ineligible.				
	To be financially eligible for ESNA, the household's gross income at the time of application must not exceed 125 percent of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines for that household size.				
	A sample of the form is attached.
