END OF THE 2007–2008 HEAP PROGRAM YEAR

<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p> Please use Print on Demand to obtain copies of forms.</p>	<p>This policy bulletin informs Job Center and Non-Cash Assistance (NCA) Food Stamp (FS) Office staff of the closing of the 2007–2008 Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP).</p> <p>The Regular HEAP component will close on Friday, May 16, 2008. Utility Liaisons must cease initiating applications for all Regular HEAP benefits at the close of business on May 16, 2008.</p> <p>The Emergency HEAP component will close on Friday, May 30, 2008. This includes the second, “supplemental,” emergency benefits for those HEAP-eligible households that have exhausted available HEAP benefits for this season and are still in a crisis situation. Utility Liaisons must cease initiating applications for all emergency HEAP benefits at the close of business on May 30, 2008.</p> <p>The Heating Equipment Repair and Replacement component of the program will remain open until September 30, 2008.</p> <p>Non-repair/replacement energy-related emergencies that occur after the close of the HEAP program year on May 30, 2008, should be processed in accordance with procedures for emergency cash assistance.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p> <p>Related Item:</p> <p>PD #07-44-ELI</p>
