The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff that: the Intensive Case Services Grant (ICSG) Program ended effective April 30, 2010; and PD #07-37-EMP is now obsolete. Due to the expiration of the ISCG, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) eligible sanctioned households that were receiving enhanced services through the ICSG program will no longer be provided with additional outreach, case management, or social work consultation services.
Services provided by the Intensive Services Center 71 will remain the same. See <u>PD #10-21-OPE</u>	All other services provided by the Intensive Services Center 71 will continue to remain the same (see <u>PD #10-21-OPE</u>).
