DATE OF STATUS (DOS) FOR NONCITIZENS WITH ALIEN/CITIZENSHIP INDICATOR CODE OF B (BATTERED)

Date: June 4, 2010	Subtopic(s): Noncitizens, Domestic Violence, Alien Eligibility
<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center staff that the Date of Status (DOS) for a noncitizen with an Alien/Citizenship Indicator (ACI) code of B (Battered) is the date of application.</p> <p>Noncitizens who meet the criteria for/or have established credibility as a battered alien must be assigned ACI code B. The DOS must always be the date of application when ACI code B is used. Immigration documents showing the <u>DOS</u> are not required for ACI code B.</p> <p>If the battered individual was deemed a credible victim with ACI code B as a result of a previous application for benefits, do not change the DOS already indicated in WMS.</p> <p>In addition, if the qualified status of an individual with ACI code B changes to another qualified status, do not change the ACI code or the DOS in WMS unless the new qualified status allows the individual to receive Federal benefits immediately.</p> <p>For more information on determining qualified alien status or battered noncitizens, see PD #09-37-ELI.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p> <p>Related Items: PB #09-105-SYS PD #09-37-ELI</p>
