<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p>	<p>The following posters have been updated on eDocs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Blow the Whistle on Medicaid Fraud” (POST-170(E)) and (POST-170(S)) are new posters that encourage the reporting of Medicaid Fraud. The English and Spanish poster size is 11” x 17”. The poster must be prominently displayed in color and at one location in all Job, SNAP and HASA Centers; and Medicaid offices. • ”What is WIC?” (POST-171 (E)) is a poster that promotes the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC). The State administered public health program helps ensure that mothers and children stay healthy. The poster size is 11” x 17” and must be prominently displayed in color in all waiting areas at all Job, SNAP and HASA Centers; and Medicaid and OCSE offices. • “Get More at NYC Farmers’ Markets! (Healthy Bucks)” (POST-172 (E)) and (POST- 172 (S)) are new posters that promote the use of a participant’s SNAP benefit card to buy food at NYC farmers’ markets to receive \$2.00 back in Health Bucks for every \$5.00 spent using their benefit card. The English and Spanish poster size is 16”x 20” and must be prominently displayed in color and at one main area at all Job and SNAP Centers. <p>Note: POST- 172 (E) and POST- 172 (S) were sent to the Centers under separate cover.</p>
