BIRTH VERIFICATION INDICATOR (BVI) PROCESS

Date: July 1, 2011	Subtopic(s): Citizenship
<p> This procedure can now be accessed on the FIAweb.</p> <p>Refer to the Temporary Assistance Source Book, Chapter 24, Section E, for information on U.S. citizenship documentation.</p> <p>Birth verification match process</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center staff about the Birth Verification Indicator (BVI) process, and the Failed Match report.</p> <p>The BVI process was implemented to provide an alternative for U.S. born citizens with a validated Social Security number (SSN), to avoid having to present original documentation to verify their citizenship status for Medicaid (MA) purposes. In the BVI process, the Welfare Management System (WMS) matches Cash Assistance (CA)/MA and MA-only cases against the Social Security Administration (SSA) database and the State Verification and Exchange System (SVES). Upon completion of the match process, a BVI indicator will be displayed in the BVI fields in both WMS and the Paperless Office System (POS).</p> <p>Data obtained from the BVI match process can be used to verify U.S. citizenship for MA eligibility, but <u>cannot</u> be used to document U.S. citizenship for CA eligibility purposes. JOS/Workers evaluating CA eligibility must still obtain acceptable proof of U.S. citizenship or immigration status.</p> <p>Individuals with any of the criteria below undergo the BVI process through the weekly systems match with SVES:</p>

- Active for MA
- Alien Citizenship Indicator (ACI) = **C** (Citizen)
- SSN Validation Code = **7** (SSN Assigned by SSA) or **8** (SSN Validated by SSA)
- BVI (Birth Verification Indicator) field = **BLANK**
- Alien Number field = **BLANK**
- SSI indicator does not = **1** (Active) or **4** (Deemed Eligible)

Note: The BVI match process does not run on Non Cash Assistance (NCA) Food Stamps (FS) cases or on FS-only individuals on CA cases.

BVI Fields

See Attachment A for screen shot examples.

The BVI indicator fields are located in the Pending Individual Data (**NQCP03**) and the Client Information (**NQIN2A**) screens in WMS, and on the WMS Clearance Report – SSN screens (**NQN10A** and **NQN10B**). The Turn-Around Document (TAD) has been updated to include the BVI indicator field next to the Birth Date field.

BVI Codes

The valid BVI codes are as follows:

Refer to [PD #10-39-SYS](#) for a detailed description of the BVI codes.

A “**Blank**” BVI field indicates that citizenship is not verified.

- **1** – Verified (System Generated)
- **2** – Verified through automated newborn process (System Generated)
- **3** – Verified by a Worker (Data enterable)
- **4** – Verified via EDITS/POS (System Generated)
- **5** – Deemed Verified (System Generated)
- **B** – Verified but not consistent with SSA data (System Generated)
- **C** – Verified but deceased (System Generated)
- **D** – Verified but deceased and not consistent with SSA data (System Generated)

All BVI values (except blank) are valid only when the ACI=**C** and the MA status is active (**AC**).

Cases that successfully pass through the BVI match process are assigned Codes **1**, **B**, **C**, or **D**.

BVI Code **2** is automatically assigned to individuals when an Unborn/Newborn is added to an MA or CA/MA case. The citizenship status is considered verified based upon the Unborn/Newborn Match process.

JOS/Worker entry of BVI Code **3**

See [PB #10-110-SYS](#).

JOS/Workers must enter Code **3** in the **BVI** field on the POS TAD if the household is applying for CA/MA and the individuals provide proof of U.S. citizenship. If Code **3** is not entered (**BLANK** BVI field), when the case becomes active, the household members with an ACI code of **C** will be matched against the SSA database. The result of the query will be entered in the BVI field automatically.

If the applicant/participant is a natural born or naturalized U.S. Citizen, the JOS/Worker must enter Code **3** in the BVI field.

Note: BVI Code **3** is the only BVI code JOS/Workers are allowed to input. It can only be entered if the current value is **B**, **C**, **D**, or **BLANK**. POS will not allow BVI Code **3** to be entered if the current value in the BVI field is **1**, **2**, **4**, or **5**.

POS will enter Code **4** in the **BVI** field if citizenship is verified via the Eligibility Data and Image Transfer System (EDITS)/POS.

Before posting codes **3** or **4**, POS will check WMS for any current BVI value associated with the chosen Client Identification Number (CIN). If there is already a value of **1**, **2**, or **5** in WMS for the CIN, the existing value will be used.

If there is no existing value of **1**, **2** or **5**, then POS will enter a value of **3** or **4** in the BVI field.

Code **5** was systematically assigned to all active CA/MA and MA-only cases in preparation for the WMS Software Release 2010.3 migration on October 15, 2010. BVI code **5** cannot be overwritten.

Applicant/Participant is not a U.S. citizen

If the applicant is not a U.S. citizen or does not provide proof of his/her citizenship, the BVI field should be left **BLANK** and the ACI code should not be **C**.

Cases with a **B** in the BVI Field

Cases with a **B** in the BVI field are posted weekly on a BVI Report file in the BVI-Reports-CA folder on the HRA/Management Information Systems (MIS) server. These cases require manual review and follow-up.

BVI report file location

Designated staff must access the BVI Report file on the HRA/MIS server by entering "[\\Ftpprod15mtc\MAPAuto\BVI-REPORTS-CA](#)" in the Internet Explorer address bar.

For each case listed, designated staff must:

- Review the HRA OneViewer for documentation verifying the participant's citizenship or alien status, and if:
 - documentation verifies the participant's U.S. citizenship, enter BVI Code **3** in the BVI field on the TAD.
 - documentation indicates the participant is a Qualified Alien and not a U.S. citizen, change the ACI code from a **C** to the appropriate code and enter the correct Date of Status and Date of Entry as appropriate on the TAD.
 - the participant is not a U.S. Citizen or a Qualified Alien, then the participant is not eligible for CA/MA/FS and his/her line must be closed.
 - there is no documentation to support the participant's U.S. Citizenship or Alien status, but there is an indication that documents exist, send the participant a Notice to Report to Center (**M-3g**) form with an appointment date 10 days from the current date and a request for documentation of citizenship. If the participant keeps the appointment but is unable to present documentation at that time, the JOS/Worker must ensure that the participant is allowed 20 additional days to submit his/her documentation (a total of 30 days from the posting of BVI code **B**).

If no proof of citizenship has been provided 30 days after Code **B** is posted in the BVI indicator, the JOS/Worker must close the CA and MA case using the following closing codes:

Case-level closing code
(HH=1)

H19 – Fail to Provide Proof of U.S. Citizenship/Identity SSA/BVI Match (HH=1)

Individual closing code
(HH>1)

H14 – Fail to Provide Proof of U.S. Citizenship/Identity SSA/BVI Match (HH>1)

Note: Closing code **H19** is also used for a multi-person household when all individuals on the case have a **B** in the BVI indicator.
