BUREAU OF FRAUD INVESTIGATION (BFI) STATE PRISON MATCH DOCUMENTS IN THE HRA ONEVIEWER

	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform staff in Family Independence Administration (FIA) Job Centers and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Non-Cash Assistance Centers that the Bureau of Fraud Investigation (BFI) State Prison Match resolution documents are now available in the HRA OneViewer.</p> <p>The BFI State Prison Match is a list of suspected incarcerated New York City (NYC) Public Assistance recipients compiled by the New York State (NYS) Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA), which is forwarded to the BFI State Match Unit (SMU) monthly for resolution.</p> <p>SMU matches this data against the Welfare Management System (WMS), the NYS Department of Corrections (DOC) Inmate Lookup System, and the equivalent inmate look-up systems of other states.</p> <p>SMU submits a resolution of this investigation to OTDA via BFI's Investigative Reporting Information System (IRIS) portal.</p> <p>Job Center and SNAP Center staff will now be able to view the BFI State Prison Match resolution documents by reviewing the Document Type Prison Match Information (9524) in the HRA One Viewer.
