	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center and Non-Cash Assistance Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (NCA SNAP) Center staff that the "Mandated Poster and Signage List for Job Centers and HRA Express Sites" (M-98c) and "Mandated Poster and Signage List for Non-Cash Assistance Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (NCA SNAP) Centers" (M-98d) have been revised.
Revisions to the M-98c and M-98d	The following revisions were made to the M-98c and the M-98d :
	 "NYS Agency-Based Voter Registration" POST-101 (E) and POST-101 (S) posters have been made obsolete. They have been replaced by "NYS Agency-Based Voter Registration" (POST-101[MLF]) poster. POST-101 (MLF) was created and formatted to comply with agency and Local Law 30 requirements. The dimension of the poster is now 18 x 24. "ACCESS HRA Your Way" (POST-195 [MLF]) has been made obsolete. ACCESS HRA "All of Your Benefits in the Palm of Your
	Hand" (OCM-42 [MLF]) is the only poster that will be displayed.
	"Source of Income Discrimination" (POST-203 [MLF]) poster was added. POST-203 (MLF) advises that it is unlawful for brokers/landlords to discriminate against a potential renter due to their income being government assistance. It also provides information about how to report this discrimination to the Department of Social Services (DSS). The poster is formatted to comply with agency and Local Law 30 requirements. The dimension of the poster is 18 x 24.
