SNAP POS Version 14.2 June 22, 2020

1. Overview of Changes

The following changes and fixes were made in this release:

- WMS (Welfare Management System) changes for release 2020.2
- ABAWD (Able Bodied Adults Without Dependents) updates
- Automated (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Application Expedited Processing Summary Sheet – NYC) (LDSS-3938 NYC) for Community-Based Organization (CBO) cases

2. WMS Release 2020.2 Updates

POS was updated to match changes in WMS and to help prevent WMS errors.

SNAP Issuance Code 16 (Monthly SNAP Benefit)

A new business rule to prevent improper usage of the SNAP Issuance Code **16** for SNAP-only cases in the **Grants** section: **Single Issuance Grant To Date cannot be later than next month.**

3. ABAWD Updates


The **Medical** section was updated to add a new indicator to capture when an applicant or participant is unfit for employment. When this indicator is selected, a value of **N** (Non-ABAWD) is selected for the individual on the **Employability Code Determination** window.

The following changes were made in the **Medical** window:

- A new bullet point was added in the main Medical window:
 - Daily Activity Limited Unfit for Employment
- The Daily Activity Limited menu label was changed to Daily Activity Limited or Unfit for Employment.
 - The value of Sick in the drop-down menu was changed to Sick or Unfit for Employment.
- Four new options were added to the Reasons for ABAWD Status drop-down menu:
 - Obviously mentally unfit
 - Obviously physically unfit
 - Obviously unfit for work (based on screening)
 - Unfit for employment at least 80 hours per month
- When the option Obviously mentally unfit, Obviously physically unfit, or Obviously unfit for work (based on screening) is selected, the Worker receives an alert: "The selection must be based on visual observations and responses to screening tool. Detailed comments must be entered to support the selection."
- When the option Unfit for employment at least 80 hours per month is selected, the Worker will
 receive a message: "The selection of unfit for employment for at least 80 hours per month must
 be due to a physical or mental health limitation and documentation must be scanned or
 requested."

4. Automated creation of LDSS-3938 NYC for CBO Cases

The automated application registration process in POS was updated to automatically complete the WMS look-ups, the expedited processing determination and the **LDSS-3938 NYC** form for cases submitted through POS by CBOs.
