EXPIRATION OF FEDERAL PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

Subtopic(s):
COVID-19, Budgeting
The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all Job Center, Non-Cash Assistance (NCA) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Center, and HIV/AIDS (HASA) staff that the Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) supplement of \$600 per week to an individual's regular unemployment benefits will expire on July 31, 2020 unless an Act of Congress extends the payments.
As a result of the expiration of the FPUC supplements on July 31, 2020, all budgets for Cash Assistance (CA) and/or SNAP that are authorized for the 8/A/20 cycle or later are not to include the FPUC supplement of \$600 per week.
