HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (HEAP) 2020-2021 COOLING ASSISTANCE COMPONENT OPENING DATE

Date: April 22, 2021	Subtopic(s): HEAP
, 2021	Purpose
	The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform Job Center, Non-Cash assistance (NCA) SNAP center, and Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) staff that the 2020-2021 Cooling Assistance Component (CAC) of the HEAP will open on Monday, May 3, 2021 .
	Applications for the 2020-2021 CAC must be accepted starting on Monday, May 3, 2021. Benefits will be provided on a first come, first served basis to eligible applicants through Tuesday, August 31, 2021, or until funds are available, whichever comes first.
	Staff will be notified if there are any further changes to the benefits closing dates.
	Applications for the 2020-2021 CAC must be processed in accordance with instructions found in <u>20-LCM-11</u> and as outlined in the New York State (NYS) <u>NYS Home Energy Assistance Program</u> <u>Cooling Assistance Component</u> reference tool.
	If applicant/participant is eligible, HEAP will provide one Cooling Assistance benefit per household for the purchase and installation of one air conditioner or a fan to help their home stay cool. In circumstances where an air conditioner cannot be safely installed, a fan will be provided. Only one air conditioner or fan, not to exceed \$800 with installation, will be provided per applicant household.
See <u>HEAP Manual</u> for HEAP eligibility criteria	As a reminder, to be eligible for a CAC benefit, the HEAP eligible households must contain at least one individual with a documented medical condition that is exacerbated by extreme heat.

Requirements for medical documentation for CAC may be waived for applicants who are unable to obtain such documentation due to COVID-19.

Additionally, the applicant household must not have a working air conditioner newer than five years old or must not have received a HEAP-funded air conditioner within the past five years, as outlined on page 2 of the attached <u>NYS Home Energy Assistance Program</u> <u>Cooling Assistance Component</u> reference tool.
