SNAP POS Version 16.1 February 22, 2022

1. Overview of Changes

The following changes and fixes were made in this release:

- Form Updates
- CBO (Community Based Organization) Updates
- Activity Due Date appears in the POS queue for any activity created through S (Streamlined) POS
- Removal of Alerts in SPOS Overview screen
- Move of Retrievals from SPOS Overview
- FSI (Application Interview) appointments added for **F11** Center

2. Form Updates

New Print to Mail (PTM) job for SNAP No Change IVRS Callers.

Elderly (over 55 years old) or disabled households in selected New York City HRA SNAP Centers will be able to use the SNAP Interactive Voice Response System (IVRS) to request the Application/Recertification for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits (ESAP) (**LDSS-5166**) to complete their recertification submission. The form will be mailed to their mailing address on file. This form will be available in all 12 languages.

3. CBO Updates

- CBO POS users are no longer able to submit Recertifications. However, users have access to the RECERTIFICATION_SCHEDULING_INQUIRY report for outreach to the applicants/participants.
- With this release, CBO POS users are limited to perform **Document Intake** only.

4. Activity Due Date in the POS queue

A fix was deployed in December 2021 to display the due date in the POS queue for the SNAP worker and approval activities started from the POS action menu or from Activity and General Information Exchange (ANGIE).

5. Removal of Alerts in SPOS Overview screen

The alerts from the **SPOS Overview** Screen are removed to reduce the amount of duplicate information displayed in the **Overview** Screen in SPOS and to shorten the time to open the screen. The information associated with these retrievals will continue to appear in the appropriate section in SPOS.

6. Move of Matches and Retrievals from SPOS Overview

The matches and retrievals listed in this section are moved to other areas of the SPOS activities from the **SPOS Overview** screen reduce the amount of duplicate information displayed in the **Overview** Screen in SPOS and to shorten the time to open the screen.

For supervisors, data is only retrieved from the available information in SPOS and new calls are not triggered in Overview.
