EXTENSION OF EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR CERTAIN NON-CITIZENS

The instructions in this policy bulletin are for Job Center, Non Cash Assistance Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (NCA SNAP) Center, and HIV/AIDS Services Administration (HASA) staff. This policy bulletin serves as information for all other staff.
	The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) may automatically extend the validity of certain Employment Authorization Documents (EAD) issued for those granted or pending Temporary Protected Status (TPS).
Refer to PD #15-09-ELI for information on lost or expired immigration documents Refer to <u>PB #15-117-ELI</u>	An individual <u>granted</u> TPS status with EAD category code "A12" or a <u>pending</u> TPS application status with EAD category code "C19" may have an expired EAD but <u>may</u> still qualify for benefits under the Permanently Residing Under the Color of Law (PRUCOL) category. Staff should determine potential eligibility and request a Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) clearance. The appropriate supervisory level staff <u>must</u> request a clearance from the Office of Refugee and Immigrant Affairs (ORIA) using the ORIA Clearance Request Form (ORIA-195) available on eDocs.
Refer to <u>PB #16-86-ELI</u>	Note : In the Job Centers and NCA SNAP Centers staff should follow the instructions for PRUCOL Eligibility Desk Aid (form W-205JJ). The staff at HASA Centers should not use the W-205JJ as the standards for PRUCOL eligibility for HASA cases are slightly different. Staff at HASA will be provided a document to use under separate cover.
