SUBJECT: 2004 Medicaid Only Income Exemption and Resource Levels

Due to a 2.1\% cost of living adjustment for SSA payments effective January 1, 2004, several figures used in determining Medicaid eligibility must be updated. Effective January 1, 2004, Medicaid eligibility must be determined using the following updated figures:

1. Medicaid income level for 1 is $\$ 659 /$ month or $\$ 7,900 /$ year.
2. Medicaid income level for 2 is $\$ 950 / m o n t h$ or $\$ 11,400 /$ year.
3. Medicaid income level for 3 is $\$ 959 / m o n t h$ or $\$ 11,500 /$ year.
4. Medicaid income level for 4 is $\$ 967 / m o n t h$ or $\$ 11,600 /$ year.
5. Medicaid resource levels increase to $\$ 3,950, \$ 5,700, \$ 5,750$ and $\$ 5,800$ for households 1, 2, 3 and 4, respectively. The income and resource levels for other size households remain the same as 2003.
6. The FBR for an individual is $\$ 564 /$ single and $\$ 846 /$ couple.
7. The allocation amount is $\$ 291$.
8. The 249 factors are .958 and .208. The . 958 calculation remained the same as in 2003.
9. The SSI resource levels remain $\$ 2,000$ for individuals and $\$ 3,000$ for couples.
10. The state supplement is $\$ 87$ for an individual and $\$ 104$ for a couple.
11. The Medicare Part A premium is $\$ 343$.
12. The Medicare Part B premium increases to $\$ 66.60$.
13. Maximum Community Spouse Resource Allowance is $\$ 92,760$.
14. Minimum Monthly Maintenance Needs Allowance is $\$ 2,319$.
15. Maximum Family Member Allowance is $\$ 521 / m o n t h$.
16. Substantial Gainful Activity (SGA): Non-Blind $\$ 810 / \mathrm{month}$, Blind \$1,350/month, Trial Work Period (TWP) $\$ 580 / m o n t h$.
17. SSI-related student earned income disregard limit of $\$ 1,370$ monthly up to a maximum of $\$ 5,520$ annually.
18. Please refer to MBL Transmittal 03-4 for 2004 federal poverty levels and SSI Benefit Levels.

MBL was programmed to use these figures when a From Date of January 1, 2004 or greater is entered. Upstate mass rebudgeting occurred the weekend of November 29-30, 2003. These changes were available on production December 1, 2003.
