This is to advise you that Friday, May 13, 2005 has been designated as the closing date for the <u>regular</u> benefit component for the 2004-2005 Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP); in addition, Friday, May 27, 2005 has been designated as the closing date for the <u>emergency</u> benefit component for 2004-2005 HEAP.

The emergency heating equipment repair and replacement component will continue to operate until further notice.

All local departments of social services and alternate certifiers must continue to accept applications and requests for applications and/or appointments to apply for <u>regular</u> benefits through the close of business (COB), on Friday, May 13, 2005, and for <u>emergency</u> HEAP benefits through the close of business on Friday, May 27, 2005.

Requests for appointments to apply for <u>regular</u> HEAP made on/or before COB May 13, 2005 must be honored even if the certifier is unable to schedule and/or conduct the appointment before COB on May 13, 2005. In addition, requests for appointments to apply for <u>emergency</u> HEAP made on/or before COB May 27, 2005 must also be honored even if the certifier is unable to schedule and/or conduct the appointment before COB on May 27, 2005.

Mail-in applications for <u>regular</u> HEAP postmarked on/or before May 13, 2005 must be accepted and processed. Phone certifications initiated for <u>regular</u> HEAP on/or before COB May 13, 2005 must also be processed.

**Note:** In e-filing districts, e-filed applications for regular HEAP with a submission date of May 13, 2005 must be processed.

Districts must continue to submit weekly pending reports until further notice. Pending cases for regular benefits must be processed no later than June 30, 2005. Benefits must be issued as soon as possible. All emergency cases must be processed through WMS no later than COB Friday, July 24, 2005.

As previously mentioned, the emergency heating equipment repair and replacement component will continue to operate until further notice.
