The purpose of this GIS message is to inform local Departments of Social Services of a name change for the Social Security Administration (SSA) Benefits Planning, Assistance and Outreach (BPA&O) projects. As described in 03 OMM/ADM-4 dated June 9, 2003, the BPA&O projects provide SSA beneficiaries with disabilities, including working age youth, access to benefits planning and assistance services. A BPA&O Cooperative Agreement Awards List was attached to the ADM so that local district staff could provide referrals to the appropriate BPA&O in their area. On October 1, 2006, the SSA awarded a new round of cooperative agreements to seven community organizations in New York State and with the new awards came a new name. These projects are now called Work Incentives Planning and Assistance (WIPA). Each WIPA project has Community Work Incentive Coordinators (CWICs), formerly known as Benefits Counselors.

The CWICs will:

- conduct outreach efforts to beneficiaries with disabilities and their families, who are potentially eligible to participate in Federal or State work incentives programs;
- work in cooperation with Federal, State, private agencies and nonprofit organizations that serve beneficiaries with disabilities;
- screen and refer beneficiaries with disabilities to appropriate Employment Networks based on the beneficiary's expressed needs and type of impairment(s);
- provide general information on the adequacy of health benefits coverage that may be offered by an employer of a beneficiary with a disability and the extent to which other health benefits coverage may be available to that beneficiary in coordination with Medicare and/or Medicaid; and
- provide information on the availability of protection and advocacy services for beneficiaries with disabilities and how to access such services.

Attached is a list of WIPAs and their locations. Local districts are encouraged to refer SSA beneficiaries to the WIPA assigned to their area if the individual may benefit from the services offered.
