### I. Purpose

The purpose of this Informational Letter (INF) is to introduce a new myBenefits poster designed to support local departments of social services' efforts with the promotion of economic supports and the <a href="maybenefits.ny.gov">mybenefits.ny.gov</a> web site.

### II. Background

This poster is an important addition to OTDA's WorkPays NY outreach campaign. The centerpiece of the poster is the new myBenefits logo and the myBenefits web address is also highlighted.

OTDA continues to promote myBenefits as a bridge to economic supports with the goal of increasing the extent to which eligible low-to-moderate income families and individuals access the array of benefits available to them.

### **III.** Program Implications

Districts can enhance efforts to promote economic supports by displaying this poster and other materials prominently within their offices and public areas. In addition, districts can share materials with area entities that have contact with low and moderate income households such as local businesses, community organizations, and non-profit organizations.
