The purpose of this letter is to transmit the 1992 income standards to be used in determining eligibility for services. State income standards are established using the federal poverty level for family size 4 as a base, adjusted by family size scale. Local district eligibility levels are recorded in Appendix F of the local district Annual Implementation Report and are used as input to the district's Title XX services matrix within the Welfare Management System.

The following are the income standards, adjusted by family size scale, which should be used in determining eligibility for services in 1992 and reflected in the 1992 Annual Implementation Report.
