The Department of Social Services is pleased to present a teleconference entitled, "Safety: A Shared Responsibility" on Wednesday, September 14, 1995. This live broadcast will feature presentations by recognized safety experts who will show staff how to be aware of trouble and remain safe in the office, in their car, and on the street. Participants will learn:

- how to recognize the signs of anger
- how to deal with hostility
- how to de-escalate a situation
- how to identify your safety risk
- how to contribute to the development of an office safety plan
- strategies to avoid becoming a victim
- specific safety tips used everyday in all types of situations

Increasing personal safety awareness will decrease the risk of becoming a victim. Personal safety in the workplace is a shared responsibility between employer and employee. This teleconference will also include a panel discussion on how your agency can address safety issues through the establishment of a tenant safety organization. Taking responsibility for safety provides a safer workplace, peace of mind and more productive staff. The topics discussed in this teleconference will enable staff to develop prevention strategies that can be incorporated into our daily lives.

There will be 37 downlink sites throughout New York State which should be convenient for most local districts. This program will also be broadcast in New York City on Crosswalks Cable Channel 74. A list of downlink sites and addresses is attached.
